Rules: This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Eligibility: Open to all J/22 class yachts.

Entry Fee: Fees are \$110.00, must accompany the registration form, and are not refundable. Fees include launching and haul out. Fees will be \$135.00 for all registrations received after **May 1.**

Registration: Advance Registrations must be received by **May 1**. Registration limited to first 30 registration forms received.

Location: Canandaigua Yacht Club, 3524 West Lake Road, Canandaigua, NY 14424 The racing area will be on Canandaigua Lake in the area near CYC. CYC now accepts all major credit cards.

Courses: Courses will be windward/leeward, typically twice around the course.

Races: Six races are planned weather permitting, with additional races at the discretion of the Race Committee. One race shall constitute a series.

Scoring: When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When six (6) races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Radio Communication: The Race Committee will communicate with competitors via marine VHF radio on a channel to be announced at the Skipper's Meeting. Race Committee broadcasts concerning its intentions, count-down to starts, OCS, etc. are a only a courtesy. Failure of the Race Committee to make a broadcast or failure of a boat to hear a broadcast shall not be grounds for redress. Except in an emergency or to report retirements and protests, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. (This changes rule L 27).

Awards: Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd overall

Mid-Fleet

Best in Club for any Club that has three (3) or more boats from their Club

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. A Crew Liability Wave will need to be signed by crew. Forms will be available on our website or at check-in.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent. Insurer and policy number is required on registration form.

Rights to use Name and Likeness:

By participating in the J-22 JACKRABBIT Regatta, a competitor automatically grants the organizing authority and the sponsors of the J-22 JACKRABBIT Regatta, the right to, in perpetuity, make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any (still) motion pictures, live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor and its material, during and after the J-22 JACKRABBIT Regatta without any compensation.

- Transport watercraft without draining water, removing drain plug, and leaving all water draining devices open
- Launch a boat or personal watercraft, or place a trailer in water if it has invasive plants or animals attached
- Dispose of unwanted live bait in water or on ground near a lake or stream.
 CYC has an approved Disposal Station for plant and animal debris from boats and trailers
